Report dated 02.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gaurav Arora, Sukhpal Arora, Renu Arora as well as of complainant Renu Sachdeva Arora it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future life and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.472 dated 21.08.2013 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station, Sector 34, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua
