Petitioners seek bail pending trial in FIR No.192 dated 04.07.2015 under Sections 307, 452, 324, 506, 447, 511, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to a compromise deed (Annexure P-3) dated 30.07.2015 to contend that since both the parties were closely related, the matter has been amicably settled because it was a case of version and cross-version. She further submits that no injury was attributed to any of the petitioners. She prays for allowing the present petition.

Learned counsel for the State submits that it is a fact that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail pending trial on their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
