Report dated 07.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurgaon has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Rajeev Agarwal, Rekha Rani, Rajat Agarwal, Sakshi Agarwal, Vipin Singhal as well as of complainant Richa Singhal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and

Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007

(3) RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.286 dated 8.10.2014 under Sections 420,406,498-A,506 and 34 IPC read with Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, Police Station, Sector 55/56 Gurgaon and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
