SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner who was earlier released on bail as per order of learned Additional Sessions Judge at Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioner Duni Chand @ Vinod regularly attending the custody except single default on 05.08.2015 and on that date circumstances were beyond his control.

Learned State counsel opposed the application that petitioner was earlier released on bail and there was no reason for the petitioner to misuse the concession of bail and allow him to release on anticipatory bail in the same case again.

Having considered the contentions raised by learned counsel for both the parties and in view of the fact that petitioner has already been

released on bail and was attending the Court proceedings regularly except for single default. He is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge. However, learned trial Judge shall be at liberty to proceed and complete the proceeding under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against petitioner and surety as well.
