Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to conclude the investigation in F.I.R. No.35 dated 17.2.2012 under Section 460 IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala and to file the final report under Section 173 Cr.PC.

In compliance of order dated 19.2.2015 of this Court, status report on behalf of the respondents by way of affidavit of Mohinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendant of Police, Sub Division Kapurthala, District Kapurthala has been filed and para No.3 of said report reads as under:

“3. That every possible efforts was made to trace the murder case of deceased Ashok Kumar Sood, but the murder case has not been solved so far. The case is 3 years old and as such no

useful purpose will be served in keeping the case pending further investigation. Under the circumstances, the untrace report is prepared by the SHO Police Station City Kapurthala on 28.4.2015 and is forwarded to the Senior officers for their approval and onward transmission to the Illaqa Magistrate for further necessary action at his ends.”

Considering the fact that the police has conducted investigation and untraced report has been prepared, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition as the relief claimed in the petition has been granted to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
