After conviction, the parties have entered into a compromise while the appeal against conviction is pending before the Sessions Court, Mansa.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the Appellate Court shall record the statements of the parties and arrive at a conclusion whether the matter has been compromised.

On the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties, it will be open to the Appellate Court to finally consider the compromise as a mitigating circumstance to acquit the accused or to grant any other benefit including the grant of benefit of doubt or for lessor punishment or probation etc.
