JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.203 dated 21.03.2015, under Sections 20, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, registered with Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

There is a recovery of 87.5 Kg. of *Ganja*, which is commercial in quantity.

The name of the petitioner has surfaced on the disclosure statement of the co-accused and on examination of call records found to be involved in the alleged offence.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Kanwar Pal, states that two main accused, namely, Salli, Driver and Munfed, Conductor of the abandoned truck where the seizure of the contraband was made are yet to be arrested.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for only grant of interim bail in the light of the due delivery of the pregnant wife of the petitioner in the month of September, 2015. In support of his plea, ultrasound report (**Annexure P-1**), as also certain documents have been shown at the time of arguments.

It is conceded that name of the petitioner has not surfaced in any other case till now.

On examination of the said documents, the prayer of the petitioner appears to be reasonable and, therefore, liable to be accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is partly allowed and the petitioner-Naveen @ Babbu is directed to be released on interim bail till 08.10.2015 subject to the furnishing of adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petitioner is also directed to file an undertaking that he shall himself surrender before the concerned Jail Authorities on 09.10.2015 at 10:00 AM.

Disposed of in the above terms.
