On 16.10.2015, the following order was passed :-

“ Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the only serious injury is attributed to Lovely and in case the petitioner is released on interim anticipatory bail, he would try to get Lovely to surrender.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, has accepted this.

Adjourned to 30.10.2015. Meanwhile, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Thereafter on 30.10.2015, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned Additional Advocate General states that on the last date it had been stated that the petitioners would ensure that Lovely, main accused would surrender but he has not surrendered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/s pray for one more opportunity.

Adjourned to 28.11.2015.

A photocopy of this order be placed on file of the connected case.”

Today, learned Addl. AG Punjab states that the said accused has not yet surrendered.

In the circumstances, both these petitions are dismissed.
