Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the husband under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.82 dated 10.06.2015, under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, lodged by the complainant/wife-Vinee Goyal.

Learned Counsel for the parties are agreed that an amicable settlement has been arrived, vide settlement deed dated 19.09.2015, before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Without commenting on the merit of the case and keeping in view the facts as noticed above, it is ordered that the petitioner shall join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to pre-arrest bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and continue to join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

Petition stands disposed of.
