This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.426 dated 23.12.2014, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, of Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Earlier bail application of the petitioner was dismissed. However, by then the report of the Chemical Examiner had not been received and it was observed in the order that the petitioner could move the Court again after the report was received. Report of the Chemical Examiner is attached herewith as Annexure P-2, which shows that the sample was identified as charas. The total quantity recovered was 1.5 kg. No fresh ground for grant of bail is made out, as the report of the Chemical Examiner affirms the nature of the contraband.
