Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439, Cr.P.C., is for grant of regular bail to Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukhi, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341 and 354, read with 34 IPC; Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012; and Sections 3(1)(xi) and 3(xii) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989, in a case arising out of FIR No.61, dated 07.05.2015 registered at Police Station, Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Learned proxy counsel submits that during the pendency of the investigation the better sense has prevailed and

both the private factions have resolved their dispute and effected a compromise. He further submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 12.05.2015 and the investigation qua him is complete, therefore, his further incarceration would not be of any worth.

Learned counsel for the State has produced the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dirba, District Sangrur, along with copy of an affidavit (Annexure R1) and copy of joint statement (Annexure R-2). On the strength of the said affidavit, learned counsel for the State very fairly concedes that the parties have resolved their dispute and effected a compromise.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, going through the material available on record and keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukhi, s/o Amrik Singh r/o village Gobindgarh Jejian, Tehsil Sunam, District Sangrur, is directed to be released on bail during pendency of trial of the present case, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
