Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 191 dated 27.11.2009 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of IPC registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur at the instance of respondent No. 2-Jagtar Singh. Petitioner No. 1, a truck driver had allegedly hit traula of the complainant resulting in injuries on the person of the complainant.

The injured has compromised the matter. Parties were directed to appear before Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate and got their statements recorded. Report has been received that the matter has been voluntarily compromised.

Following the judgment in *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, I do not find any reason to refuse the quashing on the basis of a compromise as no useful purpose will be served by prolonging the litigation which cannot result conviction. The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed being compromised subject to petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
