Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Manjit Singh and Pargat Singh, who have been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 302/380 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, in a case arising out of FIR No. 23, dated 19.03.2014, registered at Police Station, Ghagga, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Saheb Singh, Police Station, Ghagga, District Patiala, very fairly conceded that police custody of the petitioners is not required.

Considering the fact that in the challan as submitted under Section 173 Cr.P.C., the petitioners were found innocent and the fact that their custodial interrogation is not required, the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail. However, they shall appear before the Ld. Trial Court on the date fixed and the Ld. Trial Court shall release the petitioners subject to their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.
