RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 4 to 7, as the petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their family members.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Narinder Singh, has informed the Court that pursuant to the order dated 14.08.2014 passed by this Court, statements of respondent Nos. 4, 5 and 6 have been recorded on 14.02.2015 to the effect that they will not harass the petitioners in future. Respondent No.4, who is father of Kamaljeet Kaur-petitioner No.1 has stated that he has no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and he will not interfere in their married life. Statements of Kamaljeet Kaur and Harjeet Singh-petitioners have also been recorded on 18.02.2015 to the effect that

now they are not being harassed by respondent Nos. 4 to 7, therefore, they do not require protection any longer.

In view of the said fact, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition. However, in case the petitioners feel any harassment in future, they can approach the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police for protection in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
