Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.151 dated 19.11.2013, under Sections 448, 380, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.8 (Kailash Chowk), District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Mukesh Bhandari alleging that the petitioners in connivance with other co-accused had duped an amount of Rs.7,33,000/- from the complainant on the pretext of selling him a plot, but agreement of sale was torn and the complainant was threatened. Illegal possession was taken from the complainant.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

On the instructions of HC Hardeep Singh, learned State counsel informs that the police has prepared untraced report.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
