Petitioner Satish Kumar Goyal has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to decide complaint bearing No.164 dated 04.08.2007 titled 'Satish Kumar Goyal Vs. Pawan Kumar Goyal, filed under Sections 120(A), 191, 192, 193, 199, 200, 415, 499 and 500 of IPC, in a time bound manner.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner argues that learned trial Court may be directed to dispose of the aforesaid complaint expeditiously, as pre-charge evidence of the complainant has already been closed on 02.01.20015, but till date no order on framing of charge has been passed.

In view of above, learned trial Court is directed to expedite the disposal of the aforesaid case by giving short adjournments, as per law.
