AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.120 dated 05.07.2014 registered under Sections 328, 34 IPC at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners have now been in custody since 08.08.2014 and as per the FSL report (Annexure P-3) no poison has been detected.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has not been able to dispute these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
