ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the second bail petition filed by the petitioners who are seeking regular bail in FIR No.98 dated 11.05.2012, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, District Ludhiana.

The first bail petition filed by the petitioners had been dismissed on merits on 01.07.2015.

The counsel for the petitioners contends that there is a change in the circumstances as the custody now is four months.

The State counsel submits that the petitioners are accused of impersonating the original owner who are ladies and they have sold the property to Jasbir Singh who has fled the country.

The challan had been presented when the first petition was taken up for hearing. The allegations against them were that the petitioners would tamper with evidence. On that score the petition was dismissed. The case is still at the initial stages. There is no change in the circumstances even now. Charge has not been framed. The evidence is yet to start.

The petition is dismissed.
