The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Distt. Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the parties state that an amicably settlement has been arrived at between the parties. The parties have agreed to file a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act,

subject to payment of Rs.4.00 lacs by the petitioner to the complainant-wife, within eight weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.01.2015, is made absolute.

However, it is made clear that in case, the payment is not made within the stipulated period, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed without further notice.
