Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 87, dated 19.05.2015, for offence punishable under Sections 341, 323 and 324 IPC (Section 326 of IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar.

This Court, vide order dated 20.08.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 20.08.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Balwinder Singh, also submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 20.08.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
