FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 4.3.2015 under Sections 406, 409, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

The allegations against the petitioner-Inderjit Singh in this regular bail application are that he while posted as Cashier has embezzled about ₹36 lacs received from the consumers. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner is in custody from six months and that nothing is to be recovered from him and that his co-accused has been released on bail by this Court.

Though, the bail application is sought to be opposed by learned State counsel with much vehemence but having regard to the fact that the petitioner is in custody from six

months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and culpability, if any, shall be decided at the time of trial and that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
