Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioners/accused-Urmila and Krishan (maternal aunt (Masi) and uncle respectively) in case bearing FIR No.410 dated 01.05.2014, under Sections 306, 34, IPC registered with Police Station Chandani Bagh, Panipat.

As per the allegations surfaced in the investigation, the petitioners are alleged to have given beatings to the deceased husband of Reena during his lifetime on a occasion.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegations qua the petitioners are vague and have been falsely implicated at the instance of the complainant.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Prem Singh, states that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.08.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.08.2015 is made absolute.
