AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.206 dated 23.06.2015 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City.

The complainant Mohan Singh as identified by ASI Balwinder Singh is present and a draft of Rs.50,000/- has been handed over to him. In view of this the complainant as well as the learned Additional Advocate

General state that they would not oppose the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, the complainant states that he is not ready to compromise the matter as the petitioner has cheated him. Learned Additional Advocate General also states that the petitioner should not be given clean chit.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
