Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.144 dated 23.08.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.09.2013 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the parties have amicably settled the matter. Full and final payment has been made by his co-accused Jaswinder Singh Riar to the complainant to the tune of Rs.20 lacs and on the basis thereof, he has been granted the anticipatory bail by this Court, vide order dated 12.05.2015, passed separately in CRM-M-5059-2014. He prays for allowing the present petition.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, Police Station City Kharar, District Mohali, submits that petitioner

has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the above, initial order dated 30.09.2013 passed by this Court, granting interim protection to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
