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**REKHA MITTAL, J.**

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by the Court on August 19, 2014 and they are ready to face proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that the complainant has been deprived of property left behind by her father Ajit Singh, who died in the year 2013 due to heart attack. It is further submitted that keeping in view the gravity of allegations against the petitioners, they do not deserve concession of pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the State has conceded to factual assertion that the petitioners have already joined investigation and states that their custodial

interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
