RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.214 dated 26.09.2014, under Section 420 IPC, P.S. Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that husband of the petitioner has already been arrested and in pursuance to order dated 27.01.2015, petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh affirms the aforesaid fact.

Learned counsel for the complainant strongly opposes the

grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner on the ground that the amount was paid to her husband who in turn handed over the same to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however refutes the stand of complainant by saying that even before lodging the FIR civil suit for permanent injunction was filed by husband of the petitioner seeking restraint against father of the complainant in the context of some financial deal.

At this stage, without embarking upon anything on merits of the case, and in view of the fact that since the petitioner has already joined the investigation and shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency, interim order dated 27.01.2015 is made absolute.

Petitions stands disposed of.
