ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.166 dated 28.07.2015, registered under Sections 363/366-A/120-B IPC, Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Heard.

The counsel for the petitioners contends that it was a case of run away marriage. Sandeep Kaur and Valait Singh got married on 19.06.2015 and a protection petition was filed before the Sessions Court, Patiala and when the couple reached the Court complex, the family members of Sandeep Kaur were waiting outside and they assaulted the couple and with great difficulty they entered the Court complex and sought protection and interim protection was granted. It was urged that the girl was major and that fact was recorded in the order by the Addl. Sessions Judge and the same evening, the police came at their door step and arrested the

petitioners and petitioner no.1 was the mother while petitioner no.2 was the maternal aunt of Valait Singh. It was stated that the girl was living in the matrimonial home.

Perusal of the record shows that interim protection had been granted to Sandeep Kaur and Valait Singh on the basis of the Aadhar Card where the date of birth was recorded as 24.01.1996. The police had taken the prosecutrix to the medical officer but she had refused her examination.

The trial will take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.
