Petitioners seek direction to the official respondents for providing protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Notice of motion was issued.

Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani-respondent No.2 was directed to look into the representation moved by the petitioners regarding the threat perception.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajender Singh, Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani, submits that the matter has been enquired into. Statements of both the petitioners have been recorded who have stated that they do not need the protection any further because now there is no threat to their lives and liberty. He prays for disposing of the present petition as having been rendered infructuous.

After issuance of notice of motion vide order dated 19.08.2014, learned counsel for the petitioners did not appear on any of the next date of hearing including on 18.11.2014, 29.11.2014, 10.12.2014 and 19.03.2015. Similar is the position today. Neither nobody has come present

nor any request for pass over has been made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the abovesaid statement of learned counsel for the State, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
