FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.35 dated 12.04.2015 registered under Sections 307,124-A,153,153-A,420,120-B IPC read with Sections 25,54,59 of Arms Act at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application are that prior to 12.4.2015 he along with his co-accused/non-applicant Gurjeet Singh were seen by Jatinder Kumar PW, moving in the area on the day of occurrence when on 12.4.2015 Harwinder Singh Soni has been given gunshot injury by Kashmir Singh-accused-non/applicant.

The contentions of the petitioner's counsel that neither the name of the petitioner figures in the FIR nor any specific role has been attributed to him and that his name has cropped up after the six days of the occurrence and that nothing is

recovered from him and that he is in custody since 12.4.2015 could not be controverted on behalf of the State.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the trial investigations are not likely to be concluded in near future and that no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
