The petitioner is facing trial in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate at Jalandhar. He absented himself from the proceedings on 19.12.2013. Thereafter, he applied for bail before the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. The same was granted vide order dated 30.08.2014, subject to the surrender of the petitioner before the trial court within seven days. The petitioner failed to surrender himself before the trial court and again approached the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar for anticipatory bail, which was declined vide order dated 03.12.2014. I see no fault in the said order. If the petitioner has any disk problem, he has to satisfy the trial court.

Therefore, the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is dismissed.
