SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the impugned order dated 21.09.2012 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that co-accused of the petitioner, who has faced trial, has since been discharged by the Trial Court vide order dated 20.03.2014. Earlier the complaint was dismissed in default and the Court of Revision had restored the complaint but the petitioner had not received the summons issued by the Court of Revision and could not put up his case before the Court of Revision. However, now petitioner is ready to face the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to take all the pleas available to him before the Trial Court.

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Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within two months from today, he be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of Trial Court.
