DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners contends that in compliance of order passed by this Court on 21.8.2015, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have also been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that no other case is pending against petitioner No.1-Vikramjit Singh, whereas, one case i.e. FIR No. 52 dated 21.5.2011 under Section 148,149,323,324,325,326,506 IPC was registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra against petitioner No.2-Charanjit Singh but in that case

he has been kept in column No.2 as he was found innocent during investigation.

Since the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have joined the Court proceedings, interim order dated 21.8.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
