Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Surinder Singh @ Kala in case FIR No.266 dated 12.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 406 & 420 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations petitioner-accused along with his co-accused father have obtained Rs.1,85,000/- for sending son of the complainant to a foreign country and for providing a job on reaching the said country. Neither the money has been returned nor son has been sent abroad on a work Visa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigations and in fact is himself victim at the hands of one

Rajinder Singh @ Tita who a travel agent.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Bahadur Singh states that inspite of interim protection, the petitioner has not joined the investigation apart from the fact that way back on 30.10.2012 before the Economic Cell the petitioner had agreed to return Rs.1 lac along with interest and nothing has been plaid till now.

In view of the above, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
