By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72, dated 24.07.2014, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner has extended the loan of Rs. 5 lacs to the complainant. The said amount was not repaid by the complainant and the petitioner has filed the complaint in which summoning order has been issued by the competent court. After issuance of summoning order, the present case has been filed by the complainant. In pursuance of the order

dated 09.10.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, certain recoveries are yet to be effected.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.10.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
