JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

There was a matrimonial dispute between Gurwinder Singh-petitioner no.1 and his complainant wife Harjit Kaur-respondent no.2 leading to the lodging of the FIR No.167 dated 01.07.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 406 and 316 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran by the wife against the husband and in-laws.

The prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the husband and the parents in law of the complainant-wife in the aforesaid FIR.

Counsel for the parties concedes that after lodging of the FIR,

parties have amicably settled their dispute whereby they have decided to amicably part their ways subject to certain terms and conditions contained in the written compromise deed which is stated to have been drawn up and some action pursuant thereto has also been taken.

Learned Counsel for the complainant states that complainant has no objection to the confirmation of the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 20.08.2014 in the light of the subsequent aforesaid developments.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Rana Ranjit Singh also concedes the aforesaid situation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 20th of August, 2014 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
