Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Yadwinder Singh in case FIR No.20 dated 20.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code read with Section 13(1)(B), 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered with Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala.

Petitioner was appointed as a Fisherman (Class-IV post) on compassionate grounds since 28.05.2001. His matriculation certificate has been found to be genuine, however, it is contended that on the basis of allegations of 9th Class certificate being fictitious, the aforesaid FIR has been lodged by the department.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the

interim directions passed by this Court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daulat Ram submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 21.08.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
