Report dated 10.09.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malerkotla (Sangrur) has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Harjinder Singh as well as of complainant Mazher Ali @ Mazar Hussan it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties belong to the same very village and have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.119 dated 15.05.2009 under Section 326 IPC, Police Station, City Malerkotla District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
