Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner Pardeep Kumar in case FIR No.315 dated 01.12.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 392 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

The name of the petitioner has surfaced in the investigations on the disclosure statement of co-accused Ranjit that they had bought the country made pistol from the present petition.

It is contended that as such, petitioner has no role in the occurrence, apart from the fact that the said disclosure statement is not admissible qua the petitioner. It is further stated that petitioner is in custody since 02.12.2014.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Subash Chand concedes that investigations are over and the case is at the stage of recording of the prosecution evidence.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner-Pardeep Kumar and the fact that the conclusion of trial is likely to take sometime, this Court finds that he deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
