Report dated 31.8.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioners Neetin Sethi, Deepak Sethi and Suman Sethi as well as of complainant Neha Sethi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there is pure matrimonial dispute between the parties and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.111 dated 06.04.2015 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 IPC, Police Station, City Kaithal, District Kaithal and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present

petitioners.
