Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner namely Ashwani alias Ankush son of Yashpal, resident of Pingli, Police Station Sadar Karnal in case FIR No.449 dated 5.7.2015 under Sections 307/506/34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise, there is no injury attributed to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel is fair enough not to controvert the aforesaid submissions.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
