Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.277 dated 09.12.2014, under Sections 416, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 25.08.2015:-

“Notice of motion for 02.09.2015.

List along with CRM-M-10201 of 2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Harphool Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further

investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 25.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
