This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for quashing of FIR No.145 dated 03.11.2011, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Dirba, District Sangrur.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent No.1, in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dirba, District Sangrur, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that during investigation, complainant did not produce any solid proof or witness in support of his allegation. SHO, Police Station, Dirba, had submitted a report recommending cancellation of the case. Thereafter, the cancellation report was submitted before the Court on 12.12.2013. On notice, complainant had appeared and made his statement on 10.01.2014 that he did not agree with the investigation conducted by the police. Thereafter, vide order dated 10.01.2014 (Annexure

R-1) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam, case file was

returned to the police for re-investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Kaur, has informed the Court that after re-investigation, fresh cancellation report has been prepared and the complainant has filed a protest petition on 19.05.2014 before the Court.

In view of the above reply, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
