The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 28.10.2014, registered under Sections 399, 402, 212, 216 of the Indian Penal Code & Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case at the behest of Komalpreet Singh who was contesting the election for the presidential post and the petitioner supported the candidature of the rival candidate-Baljit

Singh. He further submits that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel states that the petitioner is a habitual offender and involved in as many as six more FIRs, the chart in this regard furnished by the learned state counsel duly attested by the Investigation Officer is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is named in the FIR, the nature and the gravity of the accusation and antecedents of the petitioner there is possibility that the petitioner can intimidate or influence the process of the trial.

Therefore, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
