Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.137 dated 27.10.2013, under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Chabbewal,District Hoshiarpur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 21.08.2014:-

“On the oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, complainant Anil Kumar is impleaded as respondent No.2

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready to refund the amount in question to the

complainant.

“Notice of motion for 14.10.2014.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Thereafter, the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. Parties have amicably settled their dispute before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector, Satnam Singh has submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 21.08.2014, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 21.8.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
