The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 339 dated 26.08.2014, registered under Sections 395, 397, 307, 506, 109, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injured and the complainant did not support the prosecution version and refers to Annexure P-2 & P-3. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner is in custody for over a year and and co-accused Paramjit Singh and Malkit are already on bail.

The State counsel has opposed the bail application but does not dispute the fact that the complainant and injured have not supported the prosecution version.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner and as the trial will take long to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
