The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.212 dated 28.08.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC'), registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Heard.

In pursuance of order dated 25.09.2015, the learned State counsel has furnished a copy of the agreement reached between co-accused, Soni Khan, Darshan Khan and the complainant.

On behalf of the petitioner, it is contended that the

petitioner is not a party to the said agreement. She has been falsely implicated in the present case to exert pressure, being wife of co-accused, Darshan Khan and the mother of Soni Khan. She has repeatedly joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is not the signatory to the agreement and she has joined the investigation in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 24.08.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
