CRM-12711 of 2015

This is an application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking permission to place on record affidavit of Sh.M.M. Chopra, Chairman, Managing Committee, Delhi Public School, Sector 19, Faridabad accompanied by Resolution dated 14.4.2014 passed by Managing committee of DPS School, Faridabad.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Affidavit and the Resolution are taken on record subject to all just exception.

CRM-M-32160-2012

The petitioner had filed CRM-3775-2015 praying for withdrawal of the instant main petition on the basis of the affidavit of Mrs. Vibha Singh, Vice Principal, Delhi Public School, Sector 19, Faridabad.

Subsequent to the same, today in compliance of the order dated 17.3.2015 of this Court, affidavit of Sh.M.M. Chopra, Chairman, Managing Committee, Delhi Public School, Sector 19, Faridabad accompanied by Resolution dated 14.4.2014 passed by Managing committee of DPS School, Faridabad has been filed, which have been taken on record. As per the said Resolution, Mrs. Vibha Singh, Vice Principal, Delhi Public School, Sector 19, Faridabad has been authorised by the Managing Committee to withdraw the this petition.

In view of CRM-3775-2015 and the Resolution passed by the Managing Committee, Delhi Public School, Faridabad, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not pursue the present petition and wants to withdraw the same.

Accordingly, CRM-3775-2015 is allowed and the main petition i.e. CRM-M-32160-2012 is dismissed as withdrawn.

CRM-34942 of 2014

Learned counsel for the applicant-intervener submits that he wants to withdraw his application with permission to take all objections

mentioned by him in this application before the appropriate Court.

The application is dismissed as withdrawn leaving the applicant at liberty to avail the remedy available to him under the law.
