The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C claiming that a wrongful loss has been caused to the petitioner, who is proprietor of M/s Ever Onwards Private Limited. A number of parcels dispatched for delivery to the buyers had been mis-appropriated by the staff of Post Office of Amritsar.

On instructions from ASI-Surinder Singh, it has been informed by the learned State counsel that on the order of the Commissioner of Police, ASI-Sukhwinder Singh has been deputed to look into the allegations in Annexure P-1. Since the inquiry in the complaint of the petitioner has already been

entrusted to a police official, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. A direction is however issued that the inquiry will be completed within a period of 2 to 3 months.
