Report dated 8.9.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Amanpreet Singh and Nahar Singh as well as of complainant Mohit Kumar Garg it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a dispute over money and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.70 dated 29.12.2010 under Sections 406, 420, 468 IPC, Police Station, Airport, District Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are

hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
