Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner Labh Kaur in case FIR No.40 dated 15.04.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 304 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code(Offence under Section 304-B deleted later on and Section 306 and 498-A IPC added)& therefore for offences punishable under Sections 306, 498-A & 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur.

As per the allegations the petitioner/mother-in-law along with other family members used to maltreat and beat the deceased daughter-in-law namely Harpreet Kaur leading to her death by burns.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 2.6.2015

and the challan has been presented. It is further submitted that deceased has left behind five year old girl and is not adequately looked after by father-in-law, who has been found innocent.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Mehar Singh concedes that the investigations are over and the case is listed at the stage of framing of charge.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner-Labh Kuar and the interest of the 05 year old girl, this Court finds that she deserves the concession of regular bail and as such she is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
